The October Class IV price is \$14.30, a decrease of \$1.87 from the previous month. Class IV projection for next month is \$14.15/cwt.

The September Class III price is \$16.91, a decrease of \$0.68 from the previous month. Class III projection for next month is \$17.13/cwt.



MILK PRODUCTION per day adjusted for days in the month in 24 Major States




Production per Cow per day for August 2025 in the 24 major States averaged 66.7pounds, down 1.1% from last month and up 1.37% from the same period last year.


U.S. BUTTER IN COLD STORAGE




Butter production for July 2025 was 180.1 million pounds, down 4.4% from the previous month and up 9.8% from the same month last year August data unavailable at this time.

Butter stocks for July 2025 were 331.4 million lb. down 6.75% from last month and down 6.08% from a year ago. August data unavailable at this time.

U.S. BUTTER PRODUCTION




Skim/NFDM Production






Combined Nonfat and Skim powder produced in July 2025 was 174million lb. down 11.8% from the previous month, and up 0.7% from the same period last year. Dry milk products (comparisons in percentage with July 2024) Nonfat dry milk, human 130 million pounds, up 7.1 percent. Skim milk powder 44.4 million pounds, down 14.3 percent.
