


Class IV Market News and Summary

February 1, 2018


The January Class IV price was \$13.13cwt. Down \$0.38 cwt. from last month. Class IV projection for February is \$13.15 cwt.

The January Class III price was \$14.00 cwt. Down \$1.44/cwt. from last month. Class III projection for January is \$13.30 cwt.

Milk production in the 23 major States during December totaled 17.0 billion pounds, up 1.1 percent from December 2016. Production per cow in the 23 major States averaged 1,943 pounds for December, 11 pounds above December 2016. The number of milk cows on farms in the 23 major States was 8.74 million head, 54,000 head more than December 2016, and 3,000 head more than November 2017.




U.S. BUTTER PRODUCTION





Total **butter production** for November was up 1.8% compared to November of 2016. YTD Butter production is down 15.2 million pounds representing a decline of .9%.

Butter stocks were up 6 percent from last month and up 2 percent from a year ago. Butter storage at the end of December is running 3 million pounds more than last year's December position. The inventory level the end of December looks in line with expectations. The inventory level represents about 5 weeks' worth of production.




Combined nonfat and SMP production for November is up 3.9% from last year's November total.

Stocks for November are 301.6 Million lbs. Up 40% from November 2016, but up less than one percent from last month.
