The February Class IV price was \$19.90/cwt., a decrease of \$0.83 from the previous month. Class IV projection for next month is \$19.05/cwt.


The February Class III price was \$20.18/cwt., a decrease of \$0.16 from the previous month. Class III projection for next month is \$18.50/cwt.

Milk Production per day in January 2025 in the major 24 states was .59 billion lb. per day, up 1.84% from last month and up 0.2% from the same month last year.

The number of milk cows on farms in January 2025 in the 24 major States was 8.92 million head, up 0.10% from the previous month and up 0.62% from the same period last year.




## U.S. BUTTER PRODUCTION




**Butter stocks for January 2025** were 270.284 million lb. up 26.1% from last month and up 9.17% from a year ago.

Butter production for January 2025 was 218.3 million pounds, up 9.3% from the previous month and up 0.5% from the same month last year.

Skim/NFDM Production




**Nonfat Inventory** at the end of January 2025 was 299.3 million lbs., up 16.9% from the previous month, and up 41.0% from the same period last year.


Combined Nonfat and Skim powder produced in January 2025 was 189.1 million lb. Up 4.1% from the previous month, and down 3.2% from the same period last year. Dry milk products (comparisons in percentage with January 2024) Nonfat dry milk, human 154 million pounds, up 11.0 percent. Skim milk powder 35. 5 million pounds, down 37.6 percent.
